As a nurse, Susan loved helping others. She considered it her calling. Sadly, her career was cut short when she was injured on the job and became plagued by chronic pain. Over time, she became progressively more bed-bound. As a widow without family nearby, Susan found that she was the one who needed help. She says she doesn't know where she'd be without Meals on Wheels.

"The volunteers that deliver my meals are like sunshine for me. They lift my spirits and are always asking if there's anything else they can do for me. I so look forward to their visits. In fact, I sometimes work my doctors' appointments around their deliveries because I don't want to miss seeing them!



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They are special souls to do what they do. I'm on a limited budget and also can't drive alot. Because of the regular nutrition I get through Meals on Wheels, I've been able to maintain a stable weight. I don't have enough words for what they do. How blessed am I? These people are extremely special to me."

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Meals on Wheels is a non-profit organization which has been serving Charlotte County since 1969. It is designed for senior citizen residents of this community who are unable to prepare and obtain meals for themselves. This local organization is one of 5,000 community-based Meals on Wheels programs across the country that are dedicated to addressing senior hunger and isolation.

But Meals on Wheels is more than a meal. While it does serve much-needed nutrition to approximately 150 clients throughout Charlotte County, their impact extends far beyond dietary needs. "Drivers develop relationships with their clients, helping them to feel less alone. They help identify safety or wellness issues. But it goes even deeper than that," says Debbie Amaral, Marketing Manager at Meals on Wheels of Charlotte County. "**For some seniors, their Meals on Wheels driver is the only human contact they may have all week.** Many don't have family living nearby. The staff and volunteers at Meals on Wheels become their family."



Meals on Wheels cooks, packages and delivers 150 meals each weekday — 39,000 meals per year — to clients throughout Charlotte County.
