PASSIONATE ABOUT PAYING IT FORWARD

When Tony Fulcher serves at Charlotte CARE Center, he feels God's pleasure. "I've been battling some health issues over the last year or so, but when I'm serving, I feel my best. I don't feel like I'm sick! God just gives me what I need," says Tony. "Whether it's serving meals in the kitchen, filling boxes in the food pantry or helping with landscaping, I just love being there and helping people."

The mission of Charlotte CARE Center (formerly The Homeless Coalition) is to alleviate and prevent hunger and homelessness. They offer Emergency Shelter, housing assistance, financial assistance with rent and utilities, a food pantry and daily evening meals 365 days a year.

Tony knows firsthand the life impact Charlotte CARE Center can make. It's what gives him a special passion for their mission and a compassion for those he serves. "At one point in my life, I was homeless myself. I actually slept in my car across the street from

Charlotte CARE Center. They were there for me," he explains. "They helped meet my practical needs and gave me encouragement and support. I took their Bridges out of Poverty program which gave me the education and tools I needed to get to a better place of stability."

I've been able to share what God's done for me.

Now, he feels the joy of helping others who are in the same situation he once was. "As I got more stable, and my faith in God grew, I sensed Him prompting me to step out. I truly enjoy helping the community. As I serve, I've been able to have conversations where I can share my faith and what God's done for me," says Tony. "People ask me if CCC pays me because I'm there every chance I get. I tell them I get my blessing from another Source."

CCC LIAISON HELPS MEET THE NEEDS OF THE HOMELESS

With her warm heart, outgoing personality and easy smile, Sandy Church has never met a stranger. For most of her working life, she used this skill to make "friendly" connections of the four-legged variety. "Before I retired, I was the director of an animal shelter for more than 20 years. I loved helping animals find homes," she explains. "But the most rewarding part was seeing how a furry new friend often brought love, companionship and joy to widows and widowers, and others who simply felt alone or isolated."

When Sandy moved to Florida a few years ago, she knew she wanted to continue to help people. "I'm very familiar with the non-profit world, so when we connected here at Movement, I was so excited about getting involved with our Impact Partners."

I began to pray about where God might be leading me to serve. As I prayed, the verse Isaiah 58:10 came to mind: 'Feed the hungry, and help those in trouble,'" she explains. "I knew immediately I was supposed to serve at Charlotte CARE Center. My heart's desire is to be a conduit of God's love to the hurting. It's what I've always done. Now it just looks a little different."

Sandy's heart for CCC continued to grow as she served meals to the homeless alongside friends and neighbors. "I asked people I knew to serve with me — some of whom are not believers and/or who had never done something like this before. They were overwhelmed by how kind and grateful the people at the Center were and loved how it felt to meet a need. Watching how serving affects the one serving and the one being served is incredibly powerful."

She soon agreed to be Movement Church's Charlotte CARE Center Liaison, meeting regularly with CCC to learn their volunteer needs and to help connect MC people with those opportunities. "We also discuss their material and financial needs. We want to do everything we can to partner with them in the good work they are doing in Charlotte County. The need has possibly never been greater."
